It's easy to join our volunteer community! Here's how it works.

- 1. Take a walk around your neighborhood and find a nearby storm drain that could use some attention.
- Visit https://www.ripple-effects.com/Adopt-A-Storm-Drain and follow instructions to create an account and adopt your drain. By joining, you are committing to safely cleaning the area on and around the adopted storm drain at least once a month, but preferably before every large rain event.
- 3. You will receive an email with instructions on how to pick up a free cleaning kit that includes: a safety vest, storm drain decal to place on their adopted storm drain, dust pan and broom, collection bucket and an Adopt-A-Storm Drain sticker to proudly display.
- 4. Report the amount and type of debris after each cleaning by logging into your account.

Volunteers will be included on our Storm Drain Scoop e-Newsletter, which comes out 3-4 times/year. Adopt a local storm drain and have a Ripple Effect on area waters!
