MAMSWaP Newsletter/Reminders- Sent out June 26th.

2024 MAMSWaP Stormwater Outreach/Ed. Survey- To date we've received 345 mailed responses from the 1500 surveys that were randomly mailed to MAMSWaP community residents and 168 responses to the online survey shared by partners. Survey results and a draft report will be ready in late Aug./early Sept. Results will be used to help develop the 2025-2029 5-year I&E Plan.

Rain Gardens Coaching Session Reimbursements – 16 of the 32 Rain Garden Coaching Session participants applied for and received up to \$50 Plant Dane native plant reimbursements. Applications were due by July 12th. 12 applications were from City of Madison residents and 2 from Monona residents. Types of gardens installed: 6 rain gardens, 7 downspout gardens and 3 native gardens.

<u>Storm Drain Murals Update</u>- Four new murals were painted this summer. Eight of the ten repaints are also completed. The remaining two repaints will be completed in August. All murals used a new etching process that helps the paint to better adhere to the concrete.

<u>2025 MAMSWaP Clean Sweep Events</u>- We're planning another four MAMSWaP events at Clean Sweep this spring. Events will be held after normal business hours on Saturday. Participants will pre-register for a \$5 voucher to dispose of household hazardous waste. Each community will be limited to 100-125 vouchers and the cost will be evenly split between MAMSWaP, the participating municipality and the resident, each paying \$5 per voucher that is redeemed during the event. We're offering this opportunity to different partner municipalities each year and hope to partner with Monona, Stoughton, Windsor and DeForest in 2025.

Rain Barrel Program and Plans for 2025- We've sold almost 600 rain barrels this year with 196 MAMSWaP residents applying for reimbursements. Looking into options to try and order a supply for the entire year at one time to reduce shipping costs in 2025 if we can find a way to store supply and replenish Deforest/Middleton supplies from central location. If supply run outs, we won't restock until the following spring. This will help us better predict budget costs for the year. We are considering an increase from \$78 to \$80-\$82 for 2025 to help cover all shipping and some of the reimbursement costs.

New Ripple Effects Flyers—We have a new series of 1/3-page flyers available to partners including: Plant Dane, Clean Sweep, Adopt a Storm Drain, and the Rain Barrel Program flyers. A revised 1/3-page Leaf-free Streets flyer will be available this fall. Contact Christal or Claudia if you'd like a supply.

<u>Lussier Family Heritage Center Demo Projects</u>—We're looking to install some demonstration projects in high traffic areas (parks, libraries, municipal buildings, etc.) to promote our programs and resources. This summer

we installed a downspout garden and rain barrel at Lussier Family Heritage Center. We're working on signage/stickers to add to the demo projects with QR codes to our program web pages so residents can create their own gardens or purchase a rain barrel. We'd like to get demo projects out in partner communities. If you have a good location for a project, contact us. MAMSWaP will cover the cost of the rain barrel or garden plant kits and supply signage when available.

WI Stormwater Week 2024 (Sept. 21st-29th)- An intern was hired through SweetWater to help coordinate Stormwater Week events and resources this year. Statewide events will include three webinars and a social media campaign directing people to local resources and programs. Local events are encouraged. We'll share outreach resources, links to registrations, etc. with partners soon. Please help promote these events/resources in your communities along with our Dane County events listed below.

<u>2025-2029 5-Year MAMSWaP Agreement/Contribution Schedule</u>-The 2025-2029 5-Year MAMSWaP Contribution Schedule was shared with partners on June 26th. The contribution schedule was updated based on the 2020 Census data and contributions and included a 10% increase for 2025 and a 5% increase per year for the remainder of the agreement term through 2029. We will share a draft of the 2025-2029 MAMSWaP Plan/Agreement in late October.

<u>Partner Check-In Meetings</u>- Claudia and Christal have met with eight of the twenty MAMSWaP communities this summer. The goal is to get feedback on how things are going and needs for the future. Input will be used to develop the 5-year I&E Plan along with the results of the survey this fall.
